PLAYGROUND PUMP KIT INSTRUCTIONS

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE REMOVING YOUR PUMP.

- STEP 1** – Connect city water line using ½” hard piping with a backflow preventer valve if required by local or state regulations.
- STEP 2** – Connect to the bottom of the tank shut-off ball valve with flexible piping. By removing the bottom plug on the tank, you can insert the t-wrench which will allow for opening and closing of the ball valve and allow the tank to be filled.
- STEP 3** – Tank to be bolted securely to its final placement using lag bolts provided by the end-user.
- STEP 4** – The float valve has been set to provide 7 gallons of water in the tank. Fill tank when ready.
- STEP 5** - To install the hand pump, use the four 3/8” x 1” torque head bolts and tighten evenly using the special bit provided. **DO NOT USE POWER DRIVER.**

You are now ready to use the Bison Playground Pump Kit.

NOTE: To drain the tank, remove the top plug on the side of the tank. Remove the hand pump and install the block off cover to protect the tank.
